We are pleased to present to you the first Annual Report of **Shubham Netraseva Trust** for the year 2017-18.

Based on teachings of Mahatma Gandhiji that real India is situated in her Villages, we like-minded people founded **Shubham Netraseva Trust** in August 2017 to serve our fellow Indians living in Rural-Tribal areas with sole intention to provide Comprehensive Eye Services with maintaining quality at every level of eye care. We proposed to build an Eye Hospital in the vicinity of Vansda to serve rural-tribal people in the areas of Navsari, Valsad, Tapi, The Dangs districts of South Gujarat and of Nashik district of Maharashtra state bordering Gujarat. This will make sure people don't go blind without proper treatment. Treatment will be totally free for poor people and highly subsidized for rest others.

We kept visiting and urging prominent people in Vansda to donate land for this good cause for almost a year. At last by grace of God **trust has received donation of 1 Acre of Land in Sitapur**. Land is donated by Philanthropy minded persons Mr. Sanjaybhai and Mr. Priteshbhai Bhakta from neighbouring Manpur Village. We on behalf of board of trustees and all well wishers heartily thank their great donation for the betterment of the society. This was a historic decision by the Bhakta family and historic for whole region.

We have proposed the name of Hospital in the name of their grand Mother Late Mrs. Tapiben Lallubhai Bhakta. The tentative name of hospital would be "**Tapiba Eye Hospital**".

As a part of activities, we have started eye camps every month at various places in and around Vansda. Response of the community to these camps is very much encouraging as if they just waited for someone to cater for their eye care needs. Patients from these areas have now started entrusting us for their Vision Care.

Ever since we started the trust, the support from the every section of society has been encouraging and we look forward the same in future too. Special mention is required for Divyajyoti trust, Mandvi and Sewa Rural, Jhagadia for their technical as well as moral support. Dr Anilbhai Desai and Dr Lataben Desai, founders of Sewa Rural, have always remained our inspirational figures who directed our minds in selfless service to poorest of the poor of the society led by their own examples. Dr. Udaybhai Gajiwala of Divyajyoti Trust has also played a pivotal role in making us understand how community can be served with a blend of technology and team work. These three personalities have taught us a success mantra- "Simple living and high thinking". We are lucky that we have blessings of them.

Shubham Netraseva Trust

Shubham Netraseva Trust, a voluntary Organization, has been established in August 2017 with a sole aim to improve the Vision (Eye Sight) of people by providing Comprehensive wide ranging Eye Care Services in Rural-tribal area of South Gujarat and Maharashtra.

It will be our constant endeavor to provide all eye care services with latest standards, with quality and with utmost compassion. All our activities would be centered around the patients and improving their lives by bringing back their lost vision.

In all the activities an attempt will be made to incorporate as well as balance the three basic principles: (1) Social Service (2) scientific Approach and (3) Spiritual Outlook.

The various activities of the trust would be:

- 1. Comprehensive Eye care services at proposed Tapiba Eye Hospital
- 2. Outreach Eye camps
- 3. Eye care services at satellite Vision Centers
- 4. Training and Research activities

Eye care would be provided to nearly 30 lacs people in and around Vansda.

Shubham Netrseva trust would work with various national and international Organizations, individual well wishers, government departments, industries, other health and educational institutions. to Serve the Cause By Due to this approach it will be made sure that the benefits of restoring and improving eye sight reach the "Patient"- who is the center of all our activities.

A Year at a Glance

- -We had our first informal meeting in March 2017 at Chikhli to discuss how we can go about forming a trust and start an eye hospital.
- -We then applied to register the trust and it took 5 months to get registration number through the office of Assistant Charity Commissioner of Navsari district.
- -Meanwhile we extensively met prominent people, Philanthropists, Land owners of Vansda and surrounding villages almost every Saturdays and Sundays to convince them or pass on the message that if someone can donate the land for the noble cause. We did it almost for one year but we didn't lose hope.

We, on behalf of Board of Trustees and well wishers, take an opportunity to thank Bhakta family from core of our heart.

It's an immense pleasure that Priteshbhai Bhakta also joined our Board of Trustees.

We have proposed the name of Hospital in the name of their grand Mother Late Mrs. Tapiben Lallubhai Bhakta. The name of hospital would be "Tapiba Eye Hospital".

- We had our first formal trustee meeting on 10 December 2017 at Sitapur in Ramkrishna Samvedna trust's office premises. We all agreed to start various activities like eye awareness activities, organizing eye camps and getting eye operations of the patients done.
- We conducted Eye care Awareness activities in Vangan, Raibor and Mahuvas Boarding Schools where approximately 125 students took benefits.
- We decided to start eye camps once every month as Dr. Udaybhai Gajiwala had extended support to organize camps with help of their team and surgeries be performed at Tejas Eye hospital run by Divyajyoti trust, Mandvi. We all are indebted to him for his kind support.
- A devout social worker Mr. Ajitbhai Doshi from Mumbai who dedicated his whole life in upliftment of society has been our constant guide and sponsored our few eye camps.
- A veteran social worker from Ahmedabad and also past-president of Lion's Orthopedic Hospital, Navsari, Mr. Kumarpal Shah has also been our guiding force.
- Shree Yogeshbhai Desai is helping us with print/electronic publicity of our activities like Eye camps/ Eye care awareness meetings.



Our well wisher and social worker Mr. Mahesh Lad from Kentucky –USA took keen interest in the project and has made significant efforts to spread the news of our activities and encouraged everyone to be a part of the noble cause. He also runs his own Reva Foundation and spreads the message of Swami Vivekananda. He got sponsorships of eye camps from his donor friends from USA. His sister Dr. Amita Patel and Brother-in-law Dr. Narendra Patel (New Jersey, USA) are doing regular programs to spread the information of our activities and how their friends can help our trust.

Maheshbhai Lad along with our well wishers Mr. Yogesh Patel (Dhakwada, Now at Bensalem-Pensylvenia, USA) and Mr. Chintan Patel (Soldhara, Now at Georgia, USA) has started a process of forming a trust named "Friends of the Tribes Foundation to Support us.

- Mr. Nitinbhai Patel (Pipalgabhan, Now at London, UK) also taken keen interest and has helped prepare our website and spreading awareness about the activities of our trust.
- We got PAN Number in November, 2017.
- We Prepared a brochure of our future activities and donation appeal which we distributed whenever meet people.
- The trust is very lucky that it got its initial donations by Shri Khushalbhai Bharti, Vyara in the fond memory of his late wife Mrs. Dhaniben Khushalbhai Bharti. Before her sad demise she promised our president Dr. Rohan Chariwala thet she will Donate money when he will start NGO in future. We thank her son and our trustee Mr. Bipinbhai Bharti and whole Family

Shri Nikunjbhai Desai, our Secretary and Managing Trustee of Ramkrishna Samvedna Trust, Sitapur (Vansda) allowed his office premises to be used for the activities to be carried out. He has always been a backbone for all our activities as he has good rapport with the community owing to his selfless social services for almost a decade. Moreover, He with his team takes care of advertising and managing the show at camp site. We all are indebted to him for his strong support to us.



- The first eye camp was organized with the financial help from kind hearted Mr. Sureshbhai Gandhi, from Wellington-New Zealand. We were very much encouraged by presence of Shree Jayvirendrasinhji, the member of earstwhile Royal Family of Vansda and social worker.
- Second eye camp was graced by presence of our Honorable MLA Mr. Anantbhai Patel and he appreciated our activities. Ex- MLA Mrs. Bhartiben Patel and Mr. Nardevbhai Patel were also present and encouraged us.
- Dr. Amiben Yagnik, a known General Surgeon and Social worker has helped us by introducing her Architect sister Mrs. Falguni Desai to help design the upcoming Hospital Building almost free of charge. Our trust is lucky to have got her expertise and kind support in building hospital and other infrastructure and we appreciate her kind help.
- Shree Nitinbhai Wankhede, a civil engineer/contractor and social well worker visited Sitapur. We asked him our intention to serve tribal area of Nashik district also. He welcomed the idea and promised us to help us get donation of land to establish satellite vision center with operation theatre in Surgana in future.
- We conducted three camps in this financial year and till date 8 eye camps have been organized. We examined 2737 Patients, did 153 Cataract surgeries and 18 various other eye operations, provided glasses to 1606 patients and medicines to 487 patients.
- We have got 12 A and 80 G registration so that donors can get tax exemption for their valuable donations.
- As we don't have FCRA account as of now we may not be able to bring donation from abroad but we may get one time permissions to get the same. Ours is a startup project so we are entirely dependant on Indian Philanthropists for donations to build an eye hospital.
- Rest all the activities are described in details under heading of "Activities" on coming pages.

Why we started this? (Rationale) 🕃:

Introduction:

According to Mahatma Gandhiji's words true India lives in her villages and it is a prime duty of every Indian to serve the poorest of poor person situated in the remotest part of India. Unfortunately rural India is still to receive its share of basic human needs including Health and Education facilities. A lot needs to be done in health sector in India. In the interior remote areas the availability of eye care services is far from the sight. Keeping this in mind and inspired by Gandhiji's good thoughts philanthropic minded individuals formed "Shubham Netraseva Trust" which is a registered charitable trust with sole intention to provide good quality eye care to the people of area under one roof without any discrimination based on caste, color, creed, community or capacity to pay.

Location:

We surveyed the areas and found Vansda to be best suited to start a new eye hospital as it is well connected via Public transport with nearby cities and average distance of those from Vansda is equal (Approximately 60 kilometers). Moreover Vansda is a gateway to the tribal belt of South Guiarat including that of the Dangs and Maharashtra state.

About Sitapur

Sitapur-Vansda:

Sitapur is a small village with 3000 population situated at 4 kilometers from Vansda town and is surrounded by hills covered by soothing greenery. Vansda is situated in the southern end of the eastern tribal belt of Gujarat state stretching from Ambaji till Vapi and is one of the sub-districts (Taluka) of Navsari district. Vansda taluka is adjoined by The Dangs, Valsad and Tapi districts as well as bordering Maharashtra state. Vansda is also a taluka headquarter itself with population of 15,000. What is peculiar about Vansda is it is situated at the heart of tribal area of South Gujarat. The distance of big towns like Navsari, Valsad, Chikhli, Bilimora, Dharampur, Ahwa (The Dangs' Headquarter), Saputara Hill station and border areas of Maharashtra are in the radius of 50-60 Kilometers of Vansda town. Thus geographic location and good road connectivity of Vansda town is very strategic where patients from everywhere can easily reach.

Beneficiaries:

The poor rural tribal people of districts of The Dangs, Navsari, Valsad and Nashik district of bordering Maharashtra state would be the prime beneficiaries of eye care services of our trust. Main occupation in the eastern area beyond Vansda is largely agriculture and animal husbandry. People in the area survive on very meager resources. Most of them are land/farm laborers and mostly dependent on daily income and so they spend little on their health related issues. Moreover they believe in black magic healers and also resort to traditional healers for their health related issues including eye problems. So they do not avail health services and put themselves in great danger to their own health.



In Vansda, there are no treatment facilities for various eye problems like Retina, Glaucoma, Cornea, Oculoplasty, Squint/Strabismus, Pediatric ophthalmology, Low vision and rehabilitation services for irreversible blind people. People have no other option than to go to the private hospitals in Surat for treatment which is very costly in terms of fees, transportation as well as accompanying persons' loss of daily wage. This is the reason why people do not seek eye care services and become blind in due course for the want of eye care services nearer to their place. Looking at all these points Vansda was found to be at very good location to start a new eye hospital.

Our proposed Tapiba Eye Hospital will cover 30 Lacs population of South Gujarat and part of Maharshtra.

Future Plans:

- A new 40 bedded Tapiba hospital will be established at Sitapur Village of Vansda.
- ➤ Hospital will start its activities from November, 2019.
- Emphasis of our activities would be on serving poorest of poor and Vulnerable groups (tribal groups, women, children and aged etc).
- Recruitment process for the various cadres will start in December 2018 so that they will be sent to various training centers to join our new hospital from November 2019. Funding will be required for their training at various eye institutes in India.
- For eye check up- daily Out Patient (OPD) services and for daily eye surgeries- Eye Operation theatre services will be started.
- To reach out to the poorest of the poor in the areas of districts of The Dangs, Navsari, Tapi, Valsad and bordering Maharashtra state, out reach eye camps will be organized twice a week. Patient will be distributed free or subsidized glasses, eye drops, medicines and those in need of surgeries of various kind will be brought to Base hospital at Sitapur by transportation provided by us.
- > Eye Health Education programs via slide show/ projector and talks will be organized to spread awareness on various eye problems
- Eye care services will be provided totally free or at highly subsidized rates to poor so that everyone can afford. For middle class patients eye care services will be provided at minimal rates and for affording people will be charged fully but these charges will definitely be lesser than they are in big cities like Surat.
- We target doing 1000 surgeries in the first year.
- From the beginning itself other than cataract services, Cornea (Corneal Transplant), Retina, Glaucoma, Pediatric (Child related) eye problems, squint (Cross eyes), Plastic surgery etc services will be started twice a month
- Eye doctors (Ophthalmologists) from India and abroad will be trained here in various techniques of various eye surgeries (SICS, Phacoemulsification etc)



- A very basic laboratory will be started
- Depending upon the flow of funds we will also start Community based Rehabilitation (CBR) programme for irreversibly blind people to enable them to get education and providing vocational training to make them independent in the society.
- Research would always remain at the heart of our institution.

Case Studies

Bitter Truth !!!!

It is very unfortunate that still today people go blind just because they either don't afford or don't access eye care or they fear for surgery.

Similar incident shook us a bit when we organized pilot survey eye camp at Khata-amba village of around 7000 population. The population is very sparse unlike other villages where village are comprised of thickly populated hemlets or mohallas. This village is 10 km from Vansda but reaching there is very difficult due to hilly and difficult terrain. We found 54 people having advanced cataract in the OPD of 200 people we examined that day. That was a big surprise for us !!!!!!!

We just explained the condition to each one of them and its consequence if they don't get operated their eyes as early as possible. We invited them to our main eye camp at Sitapur and to our surprise none from that village turn up.

We again went there and tried to understand the problems. We came to know that many think that being blind is a natural process of aging and we have to live with it. Sound silly but this is the situation of a tribal area of many parts of India !!!!!!. The another reason cited was that there was nobody to accompany them as young members of their family were busy in farming activities so they find no time to accompany elders. The other reason was they fear operation.

Our trustee and secretary Shree Nikunjbhai Desai has been working here for almost a decade and commands great respect among tribal people. He personally went there and had meeting with local leaders from the village. He convinced them to bring cataract blind people with our staff Miruben and Girishbhai, a couple from same Khataamba village to Sitapur and then to Mandvi Hospital.

In the next camp held in July the efforts succeeded and 6 patients came for surgery. When those patients went back happily after surgeries they counseled others to go for eye surgery. And in September more people came at our eye camp.

This infers that if we provide patients good quality eye care with compassion people will come to us for their eye related problems.

Beyond Gender and Age....

We at Shubham Netraseva trust has decided to work for all but keeping our eyes on most vulnerable groups like women, children, aged and tribal people.

We during this last year could help 3 children to regain their vision or reduce their pain and agony. Here are their stories.

1. One boy from tribal area underwent corneal transplant by Dr Rohan Chariwala at Mandvi. He had corneal opacity in his eye due to injury by Gulli-Danda in the eye when he was younger. Generally when eyesight is lost in Childhood, eye of that person becomes lazy and eyes becomes crossed without any vision. But he came with us in our eye camp. After surgery he was happy that his corneal opacity which he considered facial blemish has gone and he regained some vision too!!!!!!

Smile on his face was just awesome.

We all want smiles on the faces of our fellow Indian by curing their eye ailments.

2. Mrs Hetal, a yound lady in her 30s from village in nashik district of Maharshtra state. She suffered injury in eye and it was paining for long. She tried everywhere but pain didn't go. She came to one of our eye camps. We examined her and found that due to trauma she had developed cataract in her eyes and this has raised her eye pressure we advised her need of urgent surgery. We explained her if surgery is not done she may run a risk of becoming blind She entrusted us and came to Mandvi Hospital.

Dr. Rohan Chariwala performed the surgery and put lens in her eyes after doing thorough cleaning in the eye.

Next day she not only relieved of her excruciating pain but also regained vision in the same eye as bonus!!!!!!

She now extensively bats for us and ask patients to avail eye care services with good quality and great compassion.

3. One nomadic Muslim family with two daughters was staying on footpath of Waghai town. Elder daughter Khushboo Multani aged 4 years was blind having congenital eye anomaly and she was mentally challenged also.

We requested her parents to come with us in the camp bus to mandvi. They came. We did preliminary exam and calculated lens power under short anesthesia. She was again called for retina surgery under full anesthesia. Vitreo-Retina Surgeon operated upon her. In this case vision was irreversibly damaged but we could intervene and help her reduce complications which might have become unbearable after few months.






Place of Tapiba Hospital
